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# 1. For your Safety

For your safety and proper use of the mobile phone, please read the following guidelines carefully: Do not switch the mobile phone on when close to chemical factory, gas station or other explosive objects.

## 3. Preparation before Use

#### Install SIM Card

When registering mobile phone number, you can apply for two different phone numbers, two different mobile phone network service providers and thus obtain two SIM (Subscriber Identification Module) cards.

With these two SIM cards, you can use all functions of your mobile phone. The SIM cards save the parameters needed for communications and personal data, including PIN (Personal Identification Number) code, phonebook, short message and other extra system services.

Warning: Do not distort or scratch the SIM card nor let it contact static, dust or moisture. If it is lost, please contact immediately your network operator for help.

Before SIM card installation, please switch off the mobile phone. The SIM card is installed on the back of the mobile phone.

Follow the following diagram to install the SIM card. Please insert the host SIM card into the

NGM SIM1 slot and the slave SIM card into the SIM2 slot.

Note: If SIM card is inserted only into the SIM1 slot, then only the host works; likely, If SIM card is inserted only into the SIM2 slot, then only the slave works. When two SIM cards are inserted into the SIM1 slot and SIM2 slot respectively, you can choose work mode freely as vou wish.

Note: As the SIM card is small object, keep it out of children's touch or prevent children gulping it!



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### Install Memory card

As the mobile phone does not have enough storage space, to use some functions, you need to install a memory card (This mobile phone use T-FLASH card.)

Install T-FLASH card: Open the back cover to take out the battery, release the T-Flash card lock, insert the T-Flash card into its slot, and restore the lock and the battery before restarting the mobile phone.



Note: As the T-FLASH card is small object, keep it

out of children's touch or prevent children gulping it!

#### Install Battery

The mobile phone is suitable for original battery and accessories. When the battery is idle, it is recommended to put it into the protection box.

Follow the following diagram to install the battery.

Note: Do install the battery as per the diagram so as prevent the battery contact patch being damaged.



#### **Charge Battery**

The new battery cannot reach the optimal efficiency unless it has undergone several continuous complete charges and discharges.

When the battery is used up, charge it in time. Over-discharge can damage the battery.

After the battery is charged full, cut off the connection of charger with the AC power supply and the connection with the mobile phone.

Follow the following diagram to connect the charger.



During charging, the battery capacity icon on the screen flickers from the right to the left. After the battery is charged full, the icon is full of bars. Slight heat during charging is normal.

Warning: When a travel charger and its accessories are used to charge the battery, please firstly check if they are original or recognized by the original manufacturer. The use of other accessories may damage your mobile phone and cause risks! Always use them indoor and dry

## Notices on using the battery

The performance of the battery is affected by many factors, including radio barrier network settings, signal strength, signal strength, work temperature, chosen and used functions or settings as well as phone accessories, tone, data or other applications.

For optimal performances, please follow the rules below:

- New battery or the battery having been idle for long need charging for long. The standard voltage scope for the battery is 3.6V-4.2V.
- During charging, keep the battery at room temperature or similar temperature.
- With time passing by, the battery will gradually be worn and thus need longer time to charge. This is normal. However, after normal charging, if call duration decreases but charging time increases, you need to buy another battery from the original manufacturer or authorized by the original manufacturer. The battery of interior quality can damage your mobile phone and cause

danger!

If the phone is overused at low battery when charging, there might need a longer time for the charge indicator to be shown on the screen.

Note: Please dispose the battery according to the local regulations. Try to recycle the battery as possible. Do not treat the waste battery as common waste.

Warning: Do not throw the battery into fire so as to prevent fire. The broken battery may cause explosion.

## Warning

Charging the mobile phone by improper means can cause to explosion. Always refer to the related regulations for the disposal of the battery.

#### PIN code

PIN1 Code: It is the personal identification number used to enter SIM and able to prevent others using SIM1 without permission. If the mobile phone has activated the PIN1 code protection, when the mobile phone is switched

on, the screen will display "Input PIN". In the process of inputting PIN1 code, the screen will use "\*" to represent the input content. While obtaining SIM, you can obtain its PIN1 code.

PIN2 Code: It is the personal identification number used for some special functions such as paid call etc.

PUK Code and PUK2 Code(8-digit)

To change the locked PIN code, you need to use PUK (Personal Unblocking Kev) code. To change the locked PIN2 code, you need to use PUK2 code. If these two codes are not provided together with the SIM cards, ask the local service provider for them.

Warning: If the PIN code is input wrongly for successively three times, the SIM card will be locked. Please contact the network operator immediately for help. Attempt to unlock the code may make the SIM card ineffective forever!

# 4. General Instructions

## Dial key

It is used to dial a call (with phone number entered or in phonebook state) or receive an incoming call. In standby state, press this key to display the latest call register (SIM1 and SIM2 support respectively 20 call entries, including received calls, missed calls and dialed calls). In dual-SIM standby mode, press this key to have an option menu on which you can choose to operate via SIM1 or via SIM2.

## Switch-on/off key /End key

In call state, it is used to interrupt a call; in call conversation state, it is used to end a call or exit from the current menu and back to the standby state. Hold this key for 4~5s to switch on/off the mobile phone.

## Standard keypad

On the keypad, you can see 0-9 (A-Z keys) number keys, \* key and # key, totally 12 keys.

Press these keys to input phone number,

password, English letters, and symbols or choose menus.

In different states or different functional menus, "+" key and "Speaker" key have different functions:

- Press "SPEAKER" key long to start or exit from the silence mode.
- In music player state, "up" and "down" are used to adjust volume.

### AM/FM function key

- OK key: In radio state, press the key to stop
- In search state, press the left/right key to search channels forward and backward, press the OK key until you find an effective channel. For FM, you can have a tuning of 0.1MHz downward or backward.
- 1-9 number keys: If they are pressed shortly, you can switch to the corresponding channels saved in the channel list; if they are pressed long, you can save the current frequency to the corresponding channel.
- Up/ Down keys: Adjust volume.

### **Keypad lock**

When in standby interface, if the mobile phone is idle for certain time, it will be locked automatically. Press the "Send 1" key and "Retreat" to release. After the mobile phone is locked, the keypad cannot be activated easily; in case of incoming call, likewise, press the answer key to receive it; after that, the keypad will be locked automatically.

## Language and Input Mode

The mobile phone has defaulted abc input mode. For different areas, there are different languages and corresponding input modes.

## Call hint

The mobile phone is inbuilt with vibration motor and buzzer and provides several incoming call modes:

- Vibration
- Ring and vibration
- Ring after vibration

## Services

Services are provided with SIM kit. The mobile phone support service function. The detailed menu items depend on SIM card and the network. When the network provides such function and your SIM card supports such function, the service menu will automatically be posted in the services of the mobile phone.

## Callers' group

The callers' group in the mobile phone includes friends, family, VIP, colleagues and others etc. You can set different call tone and photo for different callers' group.

# 5. Basic operation

## Switch on

Press the switch-on/off key to start the mobile phone, then the screen will display switch-on image. Then you can enter Settings menu to set phone modes, including SIM1 & SIM2 On, Only SIM1 On, Only SIM2 On and Flight. The defaulted one is Only SIM1 On.

After insert SIM card, the mobile phone will automatically check the SIM card availability, and then it will be shown information as following on the display by sequence:

1. "Input phone password"——If you have set the password.

2. "Input PIN" —— If you set SIM card password.

"No service"—Indicates fail to make register and cannot make any calls.

The defaulted phone password is "1122".

#### Switch off

To switch off the mobile phone, press the end key. When the screen displays switch-off cartoon, the host and the slave will be off at the same time. Do not take out the battery to switch off the mobile phone. If so, the SIM card can be damaged easily and some data will be lost.

### Dial a Call

With the number keypad, you can enter phone numbers (if wrong characters are input, press the clear key to delete them). Press the dial key to dial the phone number. In SIM1 and SIM2 On state, you can choose to dial a call via SIM1 or SIM2. To end a call, press the end key; or to cancel a dial, press the Cancel key or the switch-on/off key. After the call is connected, you can see the call timer on the screen.

- Dial a call via phonebook: Enter the phonebook and search the desired name/phone number, and then press dial key to dial call.
- Redial latest dialed number: In standby state, press dial key to view the list of the latest dialed 20 phone number or names. Roll to the desired phone number or name and press dial key to dial call.

## Adjust Receiver Volume

In call conversation, press the "Previous music"and "Next music" keys to adjust the volume of the receiver.

## Answer a Call

When there is a call, as per the settings of the mobile phone, you will be alerted with ring, vibration, vibration and ring as well as ring after vibration.

To receive a call, press Dial/Call Key.

To refuse a call, press Switch-on/off key or

the end key directly.

If the CLI (Call Line Identity) is opened, the phone number of the caller will occur on the screen. If this number has been saved in the phonebook, the name corresponding to this number will be displayed on the screen.

## Send DTMF Signal

When this function is set, in call conversation, press the desired number key and \* key and # key to send DTMF signals to the other party. If such function is inactive, then extension call will become impossible.

## Dial Hold

If you have applied for dial hold, in the call conversation process, press "Options" to have the following function menus:

- Pause: Pause the current call but with the line keeping connected.
- End: End the current call conversation.
- New Call: Enter the dial interface, dial another call.
- Phonebook: Enter the directory of the phonebook.
- SMS: Enter the directory of theSMS.
- Record: While having call conversation, you

can record the call.

- Activate/Inactivate Hand free: You can activate/inactivate the speaker.
- DTMF: You can set whether to send DTMF signals.

Note: Some menu items need the support of the local network or can occur in special cases, such as Conference and New Call. Consult the local network operator for details.

### Fast Read SMS

When the user receives unread SMS, the screen will display an icon of unread SMS. Press Read to enter and read the SMS. The SIM card 1 unread SMS icon is marked with "1" and SIM card 2 unread SMS icon is marked with "2".

### Missed Calls

When there is a missed call incoming, the screen will display a missed call icon. And press Read to enter and read missed calls.

#### Connect to Voice mail

The mobile phone allows connecting the incoming call into the voice mail and then you can receive a notice about voice message. (The voice mail number must be preset).

## 6. Use of Menu Functions

## <u>Phonebook</u>

The mobile phone is provided with the business card folder type phonebook. The information of every contact saved on the mobile phone include three phone numbers (mobile phone, home phone and company phone), company name, e-mail, fax, birthday, big-head sticker, tone, callers' group (five types: family, friends, VIPs, colleagues and others). Every contact saved into SIM1 and SIM2 can only include name and number. You can browse the details of the contract.

## View

You can view contact details and modify them as often as necessary.

## Send SMS

You can send text messages to the selected contact.

## Send MMS

You can send multimedia messages to the selected contact.

## Call

You can call the selected contact.

## Edit

You can edit the details of the selected contact.

## Delete

You can delete the selected contact from the list.

## Copy

You can copy the selected contact from the phone to one SIM card (or vice versa), or from one SIM card to another SIM card.

## Move

You can move the selected contact from the phone to one SIM card (or vice versa), or from one SIM card to another SIM card.

## Send contact

You can send vCard of the selected contact via SMS, via MMS, via Email or via Bluetooth.

## Mark several

You can select more contacts at the same time and perform the necessary operations.

## Caller groups

You can set call tone, photo and members for five callers' groups. Callers' group member can only come from the number saved on phone.

## Phonebook Settings

- Reminder time: you can set the time when you want to be reminded about birthdays and many other recurrences.
- Name filter: you can choose the phonebook to be displayed (SIM1, SIM2, phone and all the possibile combinations).
- Speed dial: you can activate or deactivate this function, allowing to assign a phone number to each numerical key (2-9) and make a speed dial.

Both SIM cards of the mobile phone can send and receive SMS. The SMS is sent to the SMS center of the network and then sent by the network to the target user (GSM user). If the user does not switch on the mobile phone or the mobile phone cannot receive the SMS (the memory is full), the network will save the SMS temporarily. The duration of storage depends on sender's settings and network service provider.

With this function, the mobile phone can send and receive chain text messages, which may affect the message fees. For more information, please consult the service provider.

When the SMS capacity is full, there will be an SMS icon flickering on the standby interface. The full capacity can affect SMS reception. Delete some SMS to solve the problem.

If the other party has received SMS, you will hear the alert sound from the mobile phone (if such alert function is set as ON)

Note: When sending SMS via the SMS network, the mobile phone may display "Message sent". It indicates that the SMS has been sent to the SMS center inbox set in the mobile phone but does not mean the receiver has received the SMS. For more information, please consult the service provider.

#### Write Message

You can write message in this menu.

Every SMS can contain 160 word length English characters. To write SMS, press "#" key to switch input modes, "\*" key to select Symbol; press "Clear" key to clear one character before the cursor, long press "Clear" key to delete all characters; press the end key to back to the standby interface, press the upper and down direction key to choose characters.

The mobile phone can send the chain SMS more than 160 characters (limit for common text messages). If the SMS contains more than 160 characters, then the SMS will be split into 2pcs or more. You can insert Picture, My picture, Predefined animation, My animation, Melody, My melody, Predefined sound into SMS. However, the SMS will not be received and displayed unless the network and the receiving mobile phone support.

You can enter the phone number or choose

a number from the phonebook to send the SMS. In dual-SIM standby mode, you can choose to send the SMS via SIM1or SIM2.

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### Inbox

You can see the SMS in the SIM1/SIM2 inbox.

- ♦ View: you can view the received SMS.
- Reply: you can reply to the received SMS.
- Call sender: you can dial the number of the sender.
- Forward: you can directly forward this SMS to others.
- ♦ Delete: delete the current SMS.
- ♦ Delete all: you can delete all SMS in inbox.
- Mark as read: you can mark the SMS as "read" or "not yet read".
- Advanced: you have the options: Copy to phone, Move to phone, Copy all and Move all (from SIM card and from phone).

## Junkbox

The unwanted messages will be saved here.

## Drafts

You can save here your message as a draft — to be continued later. You can have such operations

as View, Send, Edit, Delete and use the advanced options on the messages.

### Outbox

While sending SMS, if choosing "Save and send", you can save the SMS into the Outbox. You can directly save the edited SMS into the Outbox, in such case; the Outbox will display "No number", i.e. no target number. If you fail to send the SMS, it will be saved in the Outbox. Also, you can have such operations as View, Resend (from SIM1 or SIM2), Edit, Delete, Delete all, Advanced.

## Templates

With it, you can pre-edit some common phrases, which is convenient for quick SMS editing.

## SMS settings

You can set some parameters of the SIM1 SMS or SIM2 SMS in the menu.

Profile settings: To send SMS, you must input the SMS center number.

Note: The SMS center number is provided by the network operator.

## MMS

MMS can contain words, sound and photos. If the MMS is out of the limit, the mobile phone will be unable to receive the MMS. If the SMS contains photos, the mobile phone will adjust photos so as to display them on the screen Elvis

completely.

The display effect of MMS depends on reception devices.

Note: You cannot use photo messages unless the network operator or service provider supports to do so. You cannot receive and display MMS unless the mobile phone has the compatible MMS or e-mail function.

- Add slide after: You can add a slide after the current page.

- Slide timing: You can set the play time of every slide.

After editing, you can press "Done" key to finish the MMS, in this option you can send the

MSM as following methods: send only, save and send, save to drafts or save as template, you can also set functions including: Validity period, Delivery report, Read report, Priority.

#### Inbox

You can see the MMS in the inbox and have the following operations:

- View: You can view the MMS and save photos, audio and annex.
- Reply: Reply the sender with MMS Reply by SMS: Reply the sender with SMS.
- Reply all: If the MMS you received has been sent to many receivers by the sender, with such function, you can send a reply MMS to the same receivers.
- Forward: You can directly forward this MMS to others.
- ♦ Delete: Delete the current MMS.
- ♦ Delete all: You can delete all MMS in inbox.
- Save as template: You can save the MMS as template.
- Properties: View the detailed information of the current message.
- ♦ Use details: You can extract the number in

the MMS and save it or dial a call. You can also use the URL in the MMS.

#### Outbox

You can view the MMS send and saved in the Outbox and failed and have such operations as View, Send, Delete and Delete all, Save as template, Properties and Use details.

#### Drafts

You can save the edited MMS into the drafts, and also you can have such operations as View, Send, Edit, Delete and Delete all, Save as template, Properties and Use details on the MMS in the drafts.

#### Templates

There are 5pcs preset MMS in the mobile phone and you can have such operations as View, Write message and Properties from Template. There will be the templates which the user can personally define.

Message settings: You can set some parameters

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of the MMS in the menu.

#### Compose:

- Creation mode-- "Free" and "Restricted".
- Picture resizing-- You can reduce the size of the inserted photo, including: 160x120,320x240 and Off.
- Best page time-- You can set On or Off to activate such function.
- Auto Signature-- You can set On or Off to activate such function.
- Signature-- You can edit the content of the automatic signature.

#### Send:

- Validity period -- You can set the time to save in the MMS service center and send, including Maximum, 1 hour, 6 hours, 12 hours, 1 day, 1 week.

- Read report -- You can select On or Off to activate such function.
- Priority -- Including Medium, High, Low.

Before sending or receiving emails, you need to create and activate an email account.

Before use, you need to set the e-mail in the "E-mail accounts" menu. Via this menu, you can receive and send e-mail.

- Send and receive: You can send/receive the e-mail from the specified mailbox.
- Write Email: You can edit e-mails.
- Inbox: You can see the received e-mails.
- Outbox: You can see the sent e-mails.
- Sent: You can send e-mails.
- Drafts: You can see the drafts in the specified mailbox.
- Clear mailbox: You can clear the e-mails in the specified mailbox, including inbox, outbox, sent e-mail backup and drafts, or

### Calendar

With this function, you can set the alarm clock to remind you of your schedule and record your schedule. Roll the highlight block to the desired date and then the current date will be highlighted in green. If the date is set with memo function, then this date will be highlighted in red. To view all memos of one day, press OK to see the schedule. You can have the following operations:

If you have set alarm for the memo, when the set time is reached, the mobile phone will ring and display the memo content.

### Alarm

The time format for the alarm clock is identical to that of clock. When the mobile phone is off, the alarm clock can still work provided the battery is sufficient. The system has set 5 alarm clock options and the defaulted is off. You can activate one option or all options according to the actual demand.  Change Barring Password: You can apply to the network to change the password for call barring.

[Advanced settings]

**Call Firewall Setup:** You can set here the call firewall (Black List, White List, Block numbers not saved in Phonebook, Block anonymous numbers ).

Auto Redial: You can set it as On or Off. After the first automatic redial fails, you can have at most ten times to connect a phone number.

Background sound: Background sound in call.

**Call time Display:** You can set whether to display call duration during call conversation.

**Call Time Reminder**: You can set one alert tone or periodic alert tone for several round minutes during call conversation so that you can understand call time. You can turn off the alert tone. **Reject by SMS**: You can have this function as choose it On/Off.

Note: Some settings need network support. For example, call barring cannot be used unless the local network and SIM card open it.

## Network settings

Network Selection: You can search the network again. Select your favorite network and choose to register the network automatically or manually.

Preferences: You can set the preferred registered network for SIM card.

## Security setup

- SIM Lock: You can set SIM lock (PIN code) as on/off. When this option is chosen, it is necessary to input PIN code for every insert of the SIM card.
- Phone Lock: You can set it as On or Off. It is a password of 4-8 digits and the defaulted one is 1122. You can change it.
- Auto Keypad Lock: You can set it as On or Off. The mobile phone has keypad lock

function. When it lasts certain time, the keypad will be locked, including such options as Off, 5 seconds, 30 seconds, 60 seconds and 5 minutes.

- Change Password: You can change the default phone password "1122" into 4-8-digit number easy to remember. If the phone lock is activated, when switched on, the mobile phone will hint "Phone locked". To unlock it, you can input the phone lock password and click OK.
- Certificate manager: You can browse the certificate as the phone guides.
- Privacy firewall: after inserting the password (the default one is "1122"), you can activate and deactivate the security lock for Phonebook, Messages and Call History.

# Connectivity

### Bluetooth

The mobile phone supports the Bluetooth function. You can use Bluetooth wireless technology to set wireless connection with other compatible devices, including mobile phone, computer, headset, in-car accessories etc. With Bluetooth function, you can send photo, video segment, audio segment, personal business card and memo. You can also establish wireless connection with the compatible PC to transmit files and connect to web by dialing number via SIM.

As the device supporting Bluetooth wireless technology performs communications via wireless wave, you need no keeping the device opposite to other devices but keep the distance between tem not more than 10m (about 33"). However, Bluetooth connection can be affected by wall or other electronic equipments etc. To ensure mutual operation between this device and other devices supporting Bluetooth wireless technology, consult the manufacturer to confirm whether the device by it is compatible with this device. Do not use Bluetooth function in hospitals, aircrafts, etc.

#### Bluetooth Menu

**Power**: Before using Bluetooth function, you need to activate this option. When Bluetooth function or other functions are being used, allowing this function to operate in the back desk will consume more power. It is recommended to

close this function when it is idle.

**Inquiry audio device**: With this function, you can inquiry audio device. For other devices, enter My Device to search.

My Device: After entering this option, you will see the Bluetooth devices compatible with the mobile phone. Entering options, you can have necessary operations on the desired Bluetooth device or search the incompatible Bluetooth devices.

Active Devices: With this function, you can see all devices connected with the mobile phone and their link service type. You can interrupt the specified link service.

Settings: Before using Bluetooth function, enter this menu to have corresponding settings. If your mobile phone's Bluetooth function is not activated, you can have activation confirmation.

Visibility: After this option is activated, other peripheral devices supporting Bluetooth wireless technology can see your device and its name via search. After the step audio play service is activated, this device will be unable to be searched.

Change Device Name: You can edit my

device name.

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Authentication: After this option is activated, matching is needed when peripheral device accesses my device via Bluetooth (for matched devices as well). After closing the option, no matching is needed for the matched devices.

 Audio Path: You can leave the audio on my device or send to other hand-free devices via Bluetooth. If using Bluetooth to have a call, set this path as hand-free devices.

 FTP Settings: You can set the file directory shared by my device and the access right to online Bluetooth devices.

About: Here, you can see the name of my device, my device's Bluetooth device address and the Bluetooth services supported by my device.

Tip: When searching Bluetooth devices, make sure that the peripheral Bluetooth devices are within the signal cover range and can be searched. To match the searched devices, you need to discuss with the user of this device about a pair of matching passwords. To match the hand-free device, you must input its matching password. After matching, this device will be saved in My Device view.

#### **Connection Management**

It shows the status of the connectivity.

Here you can select up to eight shortcuts for the most frequently used functions of the phone.

# 7. Coffer Function

You can access the Coffer function only after entering the password from the standby interface.

All call history, SMS etc produced by the contacts saved in the coffer will be saved in the coffer and no hint is left out of the coffer. When the coffer receives SMS, there will be SMS envelope hint and message alert tone rather than message alert menu occurring in the standby menu

The characteristics of the phonebook, SMS and MMS etc in the coffer not mentioned are the same as those out of the coffer.

Enter the coffer:

In the standby interface, input "\*", coffer password (initial value is 0000, able to be modified) and then "#" to enter the coffer.

Coffer phonebook

The coffer phonebook supports 10 private contacts.

Quick Search

You call see all contacts on the phonebook. Press the left soft key to enter the option menu of a contact and then you can have such operations as Send, View, Edit, Delete, Delete All and Save etc. Saving is to move the contact into the phonebook out of the coffer.

Press the dial key to dial a call. If the contact has false name or false phone number, then screen will display false name or number and the call history this time can be saved in the coffer.

♦ Add Entry

In this interface, you can add name, number, false name or false number.

Note: For outgoing calls, incoming calls or SMS reception, if one contact sets false name and number, then the false name will be displayed; if not, "Unknown contact" will be displayed.

♦ Settings

*View Capacity:* You can view the use status in the coffer phonebook. The display format is "Used space/Total space".

Delete All: You can clear the coffer phonebook.

*Incoming call tone mode:* You can activate or deactivate the tone for the coffer incoming calls.

# Coffer SMS

♦ Write message

You can create new SMS in this menu of 1,224 English characters.

♦ Inbox

The inbox supports 20pcs SMS. You can see the received SMS in the inbox.

- Reply: You can have a text message reply to the received SMS.
- Edit: You can edit the current SMS and send it after editing.
- Delete: You can delete the current SMS.
- Delete All: You can delete all SMS not locked in the inbox.

Note: In the coffer, to choose the contacts for SMS sending, you can see only the phonebook contacts in the coffer.

Tip: When the inbox is full, the new messages will automatically cover the earliest messages.

♦ Outbox

The outbox supports 10 SMS. If choosing "Save and Send" to send SMS, you can SMS will be saved into the coffer outbox. And you can have such operations as Edit, Send, Delete, Delete All on the SMS saved in the outbox.

♦ Coffer SMS Tone Mode

The Coffer SMS Tone Mode lets you

enable/disable the tone for the Coffer SMS.

### Coffer Call Log

It can record the missed calls, received calls and dialed calls related to the contacts in the coffer phonebook. Its capacity is 30 records. In the register list, press the dial key to dial a call.

Tip: When the mobile phone displays the alert message of the missed calls, press "Read" to enter the missed call list directly. It is possible to display false names or false numbers.

### Change Coffer Lock

You can change the coffer password, which can be of 4-8 digits. First of all you must type the old password, then the new password 2 times. Note: once the password has been changed, you must keep in mind the new coffer password; otherwise, you will be unable to access the coffer and all data could not be restored.

## Block Incoming Call

To enable/disable a block for all the calls coming from the contacts in the Coffer.

### Password Reminder

You can save here your numbers for personal accounts, passwords, ATM, etc.. Five

storage positions are available.

# 8. Editor Operation

The mobile phone provides multiple convenient input modes, which can support the use of other functions.

### **Basic letter input**

After "abc"/"ABC" or e "T9 abc"/"T9 ABC" method has been chosen, input your desired letters with the standard keypad.

### Number input

This mode is mainly used to input phone numbers etc. After "Numeric" method has been chosen, you can input digit into the place where the cursor is flickering.

### Symbol input

In any of the above input modes, you are provided with symbol input. To see the symbol list, choose "Insert symbol". If you want to use one symbol, press the up/down/left/right keys to select.

# 9. Use of USB
